Covid-19 Participant Behaviour

Snitterfield Village Hall Committee has made the Hall as safe as is reasonably possible.

These instructions are as simple as possible relying on individual common sense to fill in any gaps.

You are responsible for your own and others' safety. Do not enter unless you can carry out the requirements below.

Participants shall ...

1. Wait outside/in vehicles until the scheduled start of the event.
2. Not attend if they have any transmittable illness or are feeling unwell or if they or anyone in their household has had COVID-19 symptoms in the last **48 hours**,. Any participant who is detected as unwell will be required to leave.
3. Wear their choice of PPE (visors, face covering, gloves, etc.)- **Face coverings are encouraged to be worn at all times for anyone over 11 years of age** unless participating in an exercise class or consuming food or drink
4. If they develop COVID-19 symptoms within **10 days** of visiting these premises **participants must seek a COVID-19 test**. They must also contact you as the hirer and you must then make the Booking Secretary aware of the situation.
5. Sanitise their hands and select a seated position to sit/stand at, placing any personal items at that place (their place). On leaving all participants will remove all items including waste. Personal items such as equipment shall be sanitised before entry into the Hall.
6. Remain at their place during the course of the event as much as possible and try not to mingle with people they do not normally meet.
7. Circulate in a clockwise direction (even if it is not the shortest route) for the purposes of visiting the toilets or kitchen when leaving their place and maintain suitable social distancing.
8. The occupancy of the toilets and kitchen is restricted to two persons in the kitchen and one persons in each toilet, therefore reducing numbers in these pinch point area. Please queue if necessary.
9. Bring with them any cold drinks and food they wish to consume.
10. If food or drink is being served it must be served from the hatch and only 1 person from each household group should collect from the hatch and try to avoid a queue forming. If food and drink is served at tables you should encourage minimal mingling between groups at different tables.
11. Sanitise their hands before exiting and exit leaving a 2m gap between each person.
12. Comply with all signage.
